The Service

The Drought Support Program provides **FREE** information, support, referral, counselling and community education services to families, individuals or couples affected by drought.

Counselling includes:

- **individual** counselling
- **family** counselling
- **child** counselling
- and **relationship** counselling

to assist with **strengthening family relationships, managing conflict, improving relationships, develop parenting skills or work on any other issue that is negatively impacting on your family relationships.**



Counselling & Support

Case workers can provide support to individuals, families and organisations affected by drought in Barcaldine, Blackall-Tambo, Barcoo, Longreach, Isaac and Central Highlands local government areas. They can visit you in your home or work-place, speak to you over the phone or via Skype, or you can visit one of the Centacare offices or outreach sites.

Caseworkers will:

- Provide personalised support to meet your needs
- Provide resources and advice about self care, and about supporting families, friends and neighbours impacted by drought
- Provide appropriate referral information to access other services, including referral to free counselling services provided under our program, or referral to community education events.
- Provide individual advocacy.

The Counsellors:

- Are all tertiary qualified
- Receive regular professional supervision and training
- Hold Suitability Cards for Working with Children issued by the Commission for Children and Young People
